Special	<ul> <li>Depending on the decor and surface texture, slightly different surface visual impressions can result between cut panels viewed from different angles. These will tend to warp more severely in case of climatic fluctuations.</li> <li>Decor-structure-combination front side = Decor-structure-combination reverse side</li> <li>Due to the processing (chamfer, grind and saw) slight colour variations of the coloured material core may occur.</li> <li>Subsequent oiling (with suitable cooking oil) of the machined edge can reduce machining and wear marks.</li> <li>Please note that in everyday use, polishing, scratches and shiny spots may occur due to mechanical stress, which are particularly visible on darker decors. This does not represent a quality defect or a restriction of usability. Rather, it reflects the natural ageing of the surface.
