Interzum 2019: Pfleiderer combines design and functionality for furniture making and interior finishes



Robust functional surfaces in high-gloss and super matt

For the first time after the market launch, Pfleiderer will also be showing its PrimeBoard lacquered board at the Interzum, which was especially developed for the high standards in furniture making and interior finishes. PrimeBoard is available in the currently highly popular high-gloss and super matt finishes. While the high-gloss version develops a particular depth effect due to its mirror gloss finish, the super matt version in combination with its velvety, warm and soft touch, is particular fine on plain colours, wood variations, textile and





material decors. The use of pigmented lacquers produces an optimum colour intensity and brilliance through maximum colour stability. PrimeBoard can be implemented with an extensive range of decors and offers maximum design freedom for high-quality architecture and interior finishes through the colour match with all DecoBoard and HPL products.

The *XT*reme plus laminate board, that only recently received Red Dot Design Award, Pfleiderer introduces dark, matt colours to horizontal applications too. The particular benefits for end users: Fingermarks don't adhere and even stubborn grease marks can be removed easily – without aggressive cleaners, always looking its best. With impressive abrasion and scratch resistance, *XT*reme plus is even suitable for highly impacted interior and project fixtures and fittings.

New decors and textures complement the DST Collection

Pfleiderer is supplementing the high-quality and at the same time easy-care surfaces with new decors and textures, which pick up hot interior trends. The development towards materials such as concrete, metal and textile as well as discrete wood, stone and marble served as inspiration for new variations. The look of old industrial buildings is particularly popular. Ground concrete and stoppered surfaces produce a generously dimensioned, unconstrained industrial flair. Natural wood and artisan workmanship are also on trend. Fine, expressive grains and figure, and light-coloured decors produce lightness and freshness. Cool grey tones and textile textures create unpretentious Nordic contrasts.

Two new textures underscore the current living trends. With its rough, vivid surface, Corrosio is like corroded metal and goes particularly well with iron and bronze decors. Thanks to its fine-grained texture, Sandpearl appears matt and subtle and thus lends material and plain decors modernity and elegance. The current new products extend the variety of the Pfleiderer DST Collection and offer inspiration for the design of individual feel-good worlds, and are available now.
