Global warming and loss of biodiversity are threatening our livelihood.


Global temperature change 1850-2022 – compared to 30-year median value

As a "naturally sustainable" company, we are wholly committed to the global carbon emission targets agreed in Paris and intend to achieve net zero carbon emissions by 2050. We are equally committed to the UN Global Compact goals, and promote the ten principles in the areas of human rights, fair working conditions, environmental protection and zero tolerance corruption.

Our respective efforts – on the conduct, process and product level – are third-party verified by an external, independent organisation. High ratings from Sustainalytics (in second place out of a total of 149 companies evaluated in the category building products) and EcoVadis (gold medal and in the top 5 % of over 100,000 evaluated companies), FSC and PEFC process certificates as well as product certificates from organisations such as the Cradle to Cradle Certified product programme, the Blue Angel eco-label as well as Nordic Swan, and not least the fact that we are a German Sustainability Award 2024 (DNP 16) finalist confirm that we are on the right path with our activities for today and the future, and motivate us.

















Production of 10 % of wood-based materials using a proportion of biogenic binders by 2025


